Continuous Improvement Certification

The Quality Texas Foundation is proud to offer Continuing Education Units (CEUs) in partnership with The University of Texas at El Paso (UTEP) for each three-day training..

Requirements:

- Notify QTF of your interest in the CIC Program. Register and complete three full days of Organizational Leader Examiner Training.
- Volunteer to be assigned to serve on an Award Level application team. (Priority assignments will be given to more senior Examiners.)
- Complete both the Independent Analysis and Consolidation within the allotted time frames established by QTF.
- Attend and complete all requirements of the scheduled Site Visit throughout its entire duration. (QTF will verify with Site Visit Team Leader that all Site Visit requirements have been successfully met.)
- QTF will notify UTEP to request the participant's Continuous Improvement Certificate. The certification is valid for 1 year, and the participant is recognized during the Annual Texas Quest for Excellence Conference.

Continuous Education Units

The Organizational Leadership Examiner training is redesigned as an introduction or refresher for participants in how to use the Baldrige Excellence Framework and now contains information about how to make yourself more marketable as an organizational leader.

If writing an application, the organization should send around 5 -7 people to this training; WE teach the test! The organizational leader portion of the training should prepare participants for promotion to leadership positions in the organization.

Requirements:

- Participant must register and complete three full days of university approved QTF training.
- QTF will provide UTEP with a confirmation of attendance and completion of three-day training.
- QTF will email the participant a link for notifying UTEP to request and purchase 2 CEUs. Cost is \$20.00 per training.
